



RSCM Pacific Northwest Packing List

Music, Vestments, etc.

- ___ Course music packet (order in advance!)
- ___ 1" matte black 3 ring binder, labelled
- ___ Pencils, pencils & more pencils!
- ___ Choir vestments on a hanger, with your name pinned or taped inside each piece
- ___ RSCM badge or ribbon, if applicable
- ___ *(adults only)* Masters/Doctoral hood for Evensong, if desired

Daily attire

- ___ Casual pants, shorts, shirts, etc. for rehearsals & outings, including comfortable clothes for outdoor activities such as hiking
- ___ Sweatshirt or light jacket (you'll definitely need something for those Northwest evenings!)
- ___ Comfortable, supportive shoes
- ___ Closed toe sneakers/boots for outdoor time
- ___ Swimsuit
- ___ Pajamas, underwear, socks, etc.

Clothes for Sunday Services

- ___ Dress pants & button-down shirt, or...
- ___ Dress or skirt/dress pants & blouse
- ___ Closed toe black dress shoes (flat)

Other important items

- ___ **Linens or sleeping bag*** (youth only) (*pillow, twin XL sheets, blanket/sleeping bag, towel*)
- ___ Water bottle
- ___ Alarmclock
- ___ Toiletries (*shampoo, toothbrush/toothpaste, etc.*)
- ___ Prescription medications, if needed (***see reverse for specific instructions***)
- ___ \$40 cash for incidentals

Activities/Free time

- ___ Clothes/costumes for theme days (*check email/website in May for themes!*)
- ___ Talent show materials (*costumes, musical instruments, sheet music, props, etc.*)
- ___ Playing cards, travel board games, puzzles, etc. for down time in dorms
- ___ Books/word puzzles, coloring materials for daily quiet rest period
- ___ Frisbees, balls, etc. for outdoor recreation time

Optional

- ___ Small fan (dorms are not air-conditioned)
- ___ Bug spray
- ___ Sunscreen (a good idea for outdoor time!)

Packing notes

- **What NOT to bring**
 - Valuable jewelry, electronics, etc. (*RSCM is not liable for loss of these items*)
 - Large amounts of cash
 - Any substances prohibited by the Behavior Contract
- All packed luggage should be in a **duffle bag or suitcase**.
 - No hampers, plastic bags, cardboard boxes, etc., please!
- **Cell phones & tablets** (*rising 9th grade & up only*), electronic games, iPods, etc. are for in-room use ONLY. Electronics used outside your room will be collected and returned at the end of the course. No exceptions! **Parents, please go over this with your choristers.**
 - To reiterate, cell phones, tablets, and other wi-fi enabled devices are allowed for rising 9th graders & older ONLY.
 - If your chorister needs a cell phone for travel days, simply have them turn in their phone to Head Proctor Tim McLellan at registration, to be returned at the end of the course. Make sure any phones that will be turned in are clearly labeled!
- **Medications** should be predosed into a pill organizer and placed into plastic ziplock bag with the chorister's name printed clearly on it.
 - Maintenance medications must be pre-dosed in a labeled pill organizer, available at drugstores and Amazon.
 - If your chorister requires multiple dosages during a day (such as morning and evening), you will need to provide a pill organizer with multiple compartments per day.
 - Pill organizers must be labeled with the chorister's name, and a print out of medications and dosages is required.
